



## concept/

Marcin Rusak's hand drawn forms develop into a structural assemblage of planes, which are hybrids of domestic furniture. Three new milky white bio resin pieces, Perma 04, 05 and 06, will be presented as part of Design Miami/ Curio Projects on a stand with rose coloured plastered walls and diffused soft light.

The visitor will be invited to walk around and explore the sculptural furniture from every angle. This scenic display will present a choreographed movement of shadows and forms against the delicate ornamentation of the works. The ethereal atmosphere will highlight the subtle nuances in Marcin's material and help the viewer explore the intricate beauty of a natural world suspended in these sensual forms; petals, stems and buds are placed in a considered surface arrangement within each furniture piece, as the delicate texture and rhythm of the dried flowers and grasses are fossilised within the white bioresin. Like the veins in marble or cavities in stones, Perma's beauty can be found in the imperfections and the meticulous details of floral cross sections. All the raw material is sourced from the excess accumulated by florists; the discarded flowers are given a new life cycle by becoming the very essence of the material.


